International meeting, exhibition and round table discussion

The Community College of Art for the Carpathian Basin, in cooperation with a Transylvanian and a German organization, runs the project entitled **Barns: quality spaces for housing and culture**. The project deals with the design and promotion of innovative and green solutions for barn conversions. The

transformations are the result of the joint work of architects and visual artists. The upcoming international meeting is part of the project funded by the Creative Europe program. During the two days event we organise an exhibition and a roundtable discussion and a one day field trip to visit some good examples of converted and unconverted barns in Hungary.

Exhibition

As part of the BarnCulture project, visual artists created works that were inspired by the barn. There are works that were installed in existing barns, and some that were inspired by experiences, materials, functions or techniques related to them. At our exhibition, visitors can enjoy the photo documentation of the works created and some of the originals will also be exhibited.

The exhibition will be opened by the leaders of the three project partner organisations Eszter Rodics president of the Community College of Art for the Carpathian Basin Werner Thumann director of the Landcare Association Neumarkt in der Oberpfalz Gergely Rodics director of the Agri-Cultura-Natura Transylvaniae Association.
